Our community will only be as good as our willingness to be involved with our children. I take the safety of all the children seriously. It would be a tragedy for anyone to be hurt or to loose their home.

I need you to:

- Step in and stop the dangerous actions.
- Find out who the kids are and where they live.
- Report to the Fire Department if actions involve fire. **Call 911.**
